Operating Budget Estimate

If the system's operating budget request of \$273 million is fully funded, Renton Technical College will receive approximately \$11.4 million in additional funding.

Capital Budget Estimate

If the system's request is fully funded, Renton Technical College will receive approximately \$4,123,800 for operation, maintenance, infrastructure, repairs, and minor improvements of its existing facilities, and \$51,858,000 for construction of the Health Sciences Center.
