## FEDERAL AID - CONDITIONS OF AWARD

As a financial aid recipient, you understand and acknowledge that:

- 1. You will only use the financial aid funds you receive for education expenses that you incur while attending Renton Technical College.
- 2. You must maintain satisfactory progress and attendance as defined for financial aid recipients, in order to remain eligible.
- 3. You understand that you must enroll in an eligible program of study and will only be awarded financial aid for classes that are required for that program.
- 4. You understand that you may not receive Federal Pell Grant funds at two colleges concurrently.
- 5. As a financial aid recipient, you are subject to the financial aid refund and repayment policies. You must inform the financial aid office if you withdraw. If it is determined that there are funds you need to repay and you fail to do so, your account will be assigned to a collection agency.
- You authorize Renton Technical College to use the proceeds from your Grants and/or Loans to pay tuition & fees required for your training program.
- 7. You must report any changes which affect your financial resources as they occur. This includes changes in your and/or your parents' income, marital status, scholarships, grants, loans, gifts and employment.
- 8. Most financial aid awards are subject to the availability of funds. If you are awarded aid, it will depend on federal allocations to the college and may be adjusted if allocations are not sufficient.
- 9. In addition, you certify that you do not owe a refund or repayment on a Pell Grant or a SEOG, or that you are not in default on a loan insured or guaranteed under the Perkins, National Direct, FFELP, or William D. Ford programs.
